



PUBLIC COMMENTS MATTER.

As daunting as it might seem, submitting a comment to the Public Service Commission is actually really easy. You don't need to be an expert to make a big impact.

YOUR VOICE HELPS SHAPE PSC DECISIONS THAT AFFECT YOUR LIFE.

The Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) is responsible for ensuring profit-driven utilities provide safe, reliable service at a fair and just price. The PSC hears cases and makes decisions related to energy rates (our power bills) and the energy efficiency programs offered by our utility companies. They also approve or deny the build-out of new power generation.

WRITTEN COMMENTS

Use the K4ED website

You can learn about many PSC cases and submit your comment through our website:

2. **Click** on your utility company's name.
3. **Read** about current cases.
4. Click **Submit A Comment** (if available) to open a comment form.

SPEAK FROM THE HEART

Public advocacy organizations will hire experts to make technical comments to etc PSC, so don't feel like you have to be an expert for your comment to matter.

The commission wants to hear from you: how you are directly impacted, what your concerns are, and what you think should be in the utility's plan for the next 15 years. Worried about paying your bills? The impacts of climate change on your children? Utilities asking for another rate hike, when their CEOs make millions? Those are all valid concerns that the commission needs to hear.

ORAL COMMENTS

In addition to submitting written comments, people also have the opportunity to make oral comments at the beginning of a case's final hearing in front of the PSC. These comments can be done in person or virtually.

You can find the date of a case's formal hearing in the case scheduling order on the PSC's website.

To be added to the list of oral comments, email psc.meeting@ky.gov or simply show up at the PSC office at 211 Sower Blvd, Frankfort, KY 40601.

Be sure to include the case number in the subject line and your contact information in the body of the email request

Pro Tip: bring your kids or elderly parents into the room while you give your comment. The PSC needs to see the faces of the people that it's their job to protect.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- You will get 2-3 minutes for your comment (and possibly more if there aren't many people signed up). Prepare and practice your comment ahead of time. Focus on making your most important points in that timeframe.
- K4ED has background information and sample talking points for many cases on our website at k4ed.org/public-comment.html.
- While it can seem intimidating, commenting is actually quite painless. The commission will listen without asking questions or making comments. This is a chance to ensure your voice is heard in the process.
